Category Descriptions

Performance

Quarterly score based on a manager's performance relative to its benchmark

Organization & Operations

Includes factors such as organization, professional staff, diversity & inclusion, investment philosophy & process, risk management, legal & compliance framework
 'S' stands for Satisfactory

ESG

Evaluates the extent to which material ESG factors are identified, assessed, and incorporated into risk/return analysis and portfolio construction
 '—' denotes passive index funds and cash where ESG scores are not relevant and/or reflect strategies that do not incorporate active decisions, including ESG considerations, in portfolio construction

Partnership

Blended score based on:
